**Central nervous system anomalies**

- Corpus callosum agenesis
- Hydrocephaly

**Facial, jugular and cranial anomalies**

- Reverse lips
- Bigger dysplastic ears
- Distinctive forehead
- Wide nose
- Microphthalmia
- Cataract

**Cardiovascular anomalies (40-60%)**

- VSD
- ASD
- Major vascular anomalies

**Urinary system anomalies**

- Hydronephrosis-reflux

**Reproductive system anomalies**

- Cryptorchidism

**Gastrointestinal anomalies**

- Diaphragmatic hernia
- Esophagial atresia
- Lack of gall bladder

**Skeletal system anomalies**

- Vertebral anomalies (Hemivertebra, spina bifida, kyphoscoliosis)
- Joint contractures
- Abnormal metacarpal and metatarsal bones
- Simian line
- Deep longitudinal plantar line

**Other findings and anomalies**

- Related malignities
- They may be related with advanced maternal-paternal age
